February Meeting Updates...

February 5

Mayor Judy Anderson shared an update on the development of Downtown. A new Hyatt Palma study on downtown had just been completed. The study suggested angled parking to slow traffic in downtown Terre Haute. She noted that the National Road Heritage Trail would be breaking ground soon. Mayor Anderson also noted that the new Cherry Street parking garage is in its planning phases. It is designed to include shops and a bus station. The downtown will also benefit from the renovation of the Federal Building and soon, the renovation of the Terre Haute House should be announced.

Mike Kukewich received his blue pin for completing the 5 star program.

February 12

Dr. Jeff Edwards spoke about his scientific expedition up Mt. McKinley. His group studied nutrition and weight at altitude. The climb is very dangerous and 11 climbers died while his group was there. Their tents had to be buried in the snow to protect them from the cold and wind during the night. During storms they had to dig snow away from the tents to prevent suffocation. 20 degrees was the warmest temperature and the wind chill at night might reach -150 degrees.

February 19

Donnie Wagner of the NCAA advised that the NCAA

serves 360,000 student athletes as they participate in athletics. Out of last year's \$325.6 million budget, the NCAA kept 6 % for operating overhead while the remaining dollars went back to the member schools. Mr. Wagner shared that on March 15 and 16, the first of 2 years where the Division 3 Women's Basketball championship will be played at Hulbert Arena at RHIT.

February 26

Craig McKee shared why Rotary is more than a lunch club. It is an organization of business leaders throughout the world. Craig announced our Club's commitment to raising funds through the establishment of 10 for 1 clubs. Through these clubs, 10 Rotarians form a team, each contributing \$100 per year for 10 years until all team members are Paul Harris Fellows. Craig challenged the Club membership to forming 3 new 10 for 1 Clubs. Additionally he announced that 2 new Second Tier Clubs would be formed to encourage current Paul Harris Fellows to receive a second award.

Gary Morris received his Blue Pin for completing the 5 star program.
