April 1: Rotary Interact hosted our club meeting at TH North High School. The Counter Points entertained with selections from Les Miserables. District Governor-Elect Randy Bridges visited the Club.

April 8: Group Study Exchange from Nigeria visited and discussed his or her home state and profession.

April 15: Dr. Jim Buechler discussed rural health and technology, a concept begun in 1976 at Union Hospital. He demonstrated a computer program developed with a Rose-Hulman student that allows rural doctors to consult worldwide with specialists.

April 22: Rick Card and Col. Marcourt talked about the Newport Munitions Depot. The neutralization of chemicals continues to be in compliance with the 1997 treaty and all materials will be eliminated by 2007. Storage is now in 8 hardened earthen magazines.

April 29: Steve Witt of the Terre Haute/Vigo County Department of Redevelopment shared the current activities which included Block grant programs, the Coke and Carbon property redevelopment, and a proposed Cherry St. parking garage.

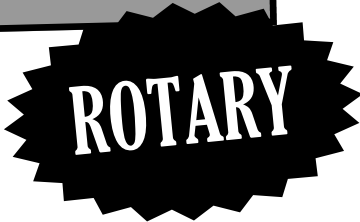
